Arun District Council	Arun District Council will deliver public realm enhancements in the riverbank area of Littlehampton; creating a sense of destination and establishing improved links between the town centre, seafront and riverside. This project will be delivered in partnership with the Environment Agency, West Sussex County Council and Littlehampton Harbour Board and will be the economic development complement for a major new flood defence scheme along the East Bank of the River Arun, which will safeguard businesses and enable opportunities for jobs growth.	£573,148
Rosehill Arts Trust	Rosehill Arts Trust will renovate and extend the unique Oliver Messel designed Rosehill Theatre, creating a new contemporary arts centre and restaurant in Moresby near Whitehaven, West Cumbria. The project will include the creation of a contemporary front of house, exhibition space, café and an enlarged foyer; the renovation of the theatre's unique auditorium and foyer; backstage facilities for artists and performers; the creation of a fully accessible front of house and new theatre entrance. The project will create and safeguard jobs currently at risk and attract new visitors to the area, supporting local businesses.	£451,832

Thanet District Council	Thanet District Council will bring back into economic use, key elements within the iconic but derelict Art Deco Cinema within the Dreamland site in Margate, Kent. Refurbishment works will allow for a unique space to be created and run as a commercially viable, high quality restaurant in a Grade II Listed building. This pump-priming will enable long-term use of not just the restaurant but the whole of the cinema complex, bringing the external front façade and original building back to its 1930's glory. The project will attract new visitors to the area, supporting local businesses and creating jobs.	£1,898,556
